

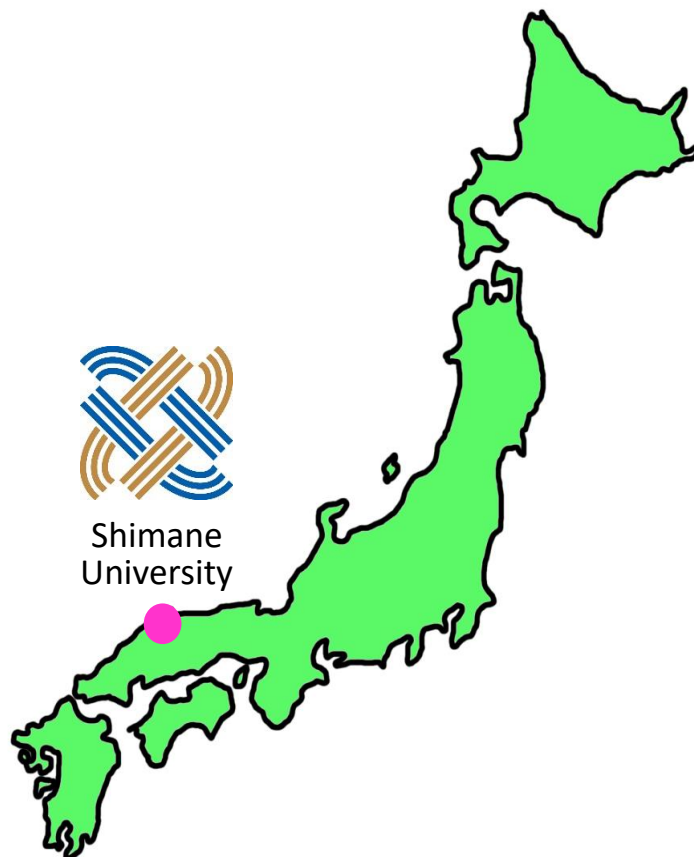
# English-Japanese Bilingual Education Course for International Students

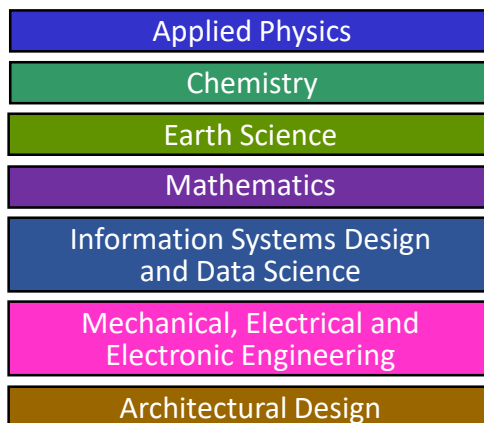

### Application Requirements

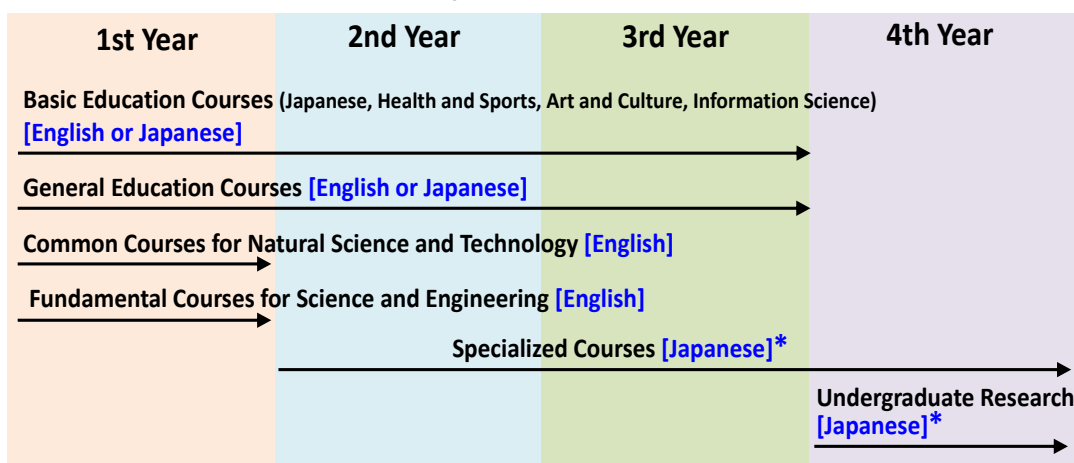
